# Video Library Goals

- Make video resources from Gallaudet TV, Library, and Alumni Office available online for education, research, and other uses
- Promote Deaf Culture, Deaf History, and American Sign Language (ASL)
- Create visual histories and collect stories from Deaf community
- Create lesson plans and curricular activities for using the Gallaudet Video Library

# Gallaudet University

- World's only liberal arts program for deaf and hard-of-hearing
- Research center
- Archives
  - Literally thousands of unduplicated assets – films, artifacts, documents
  - Some films as early as 1910
- Production facility
  - Mid-1970s to present

- \$200,000 software grant from North Plains Systems

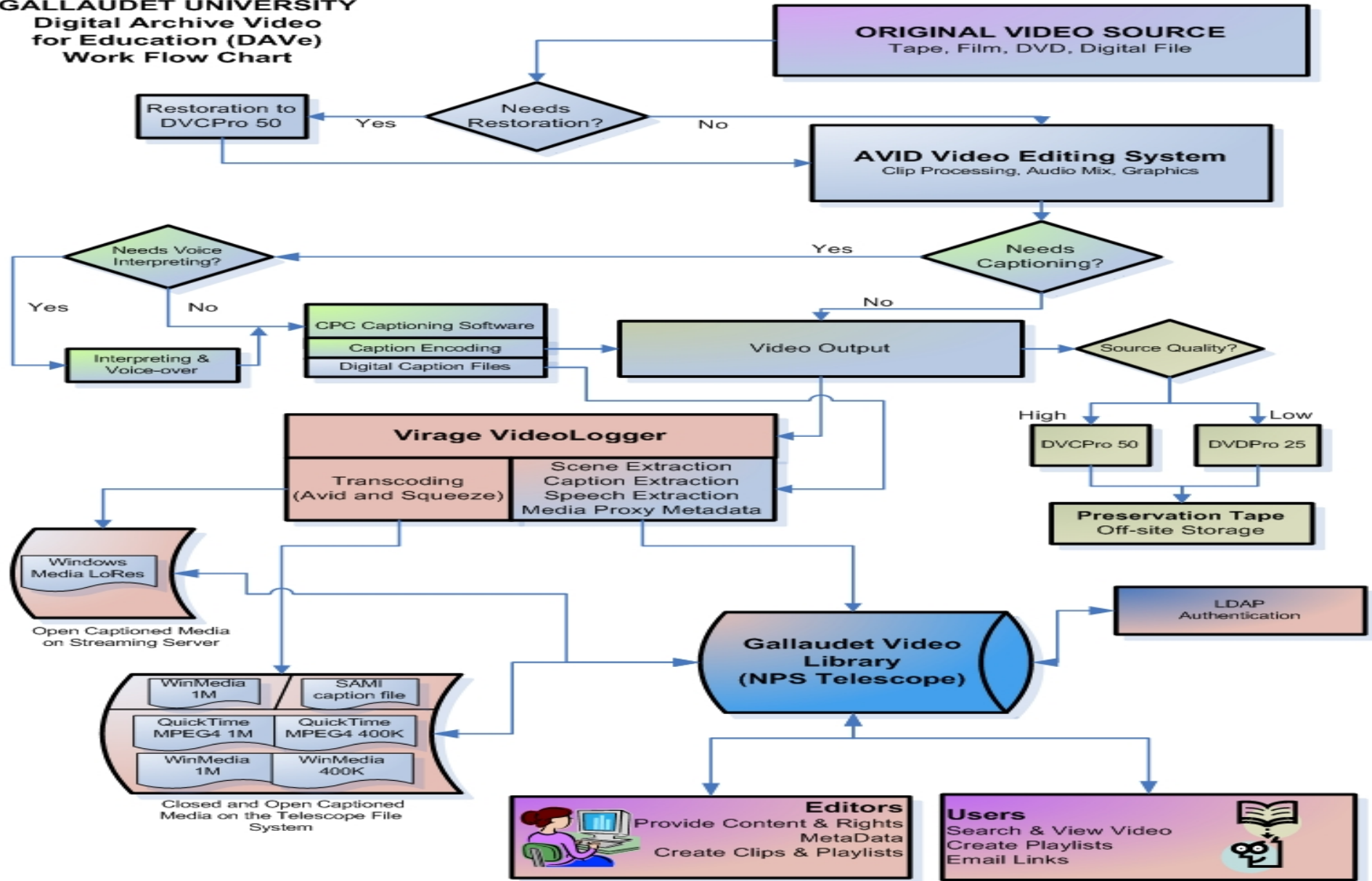

# Technology Infrastructure

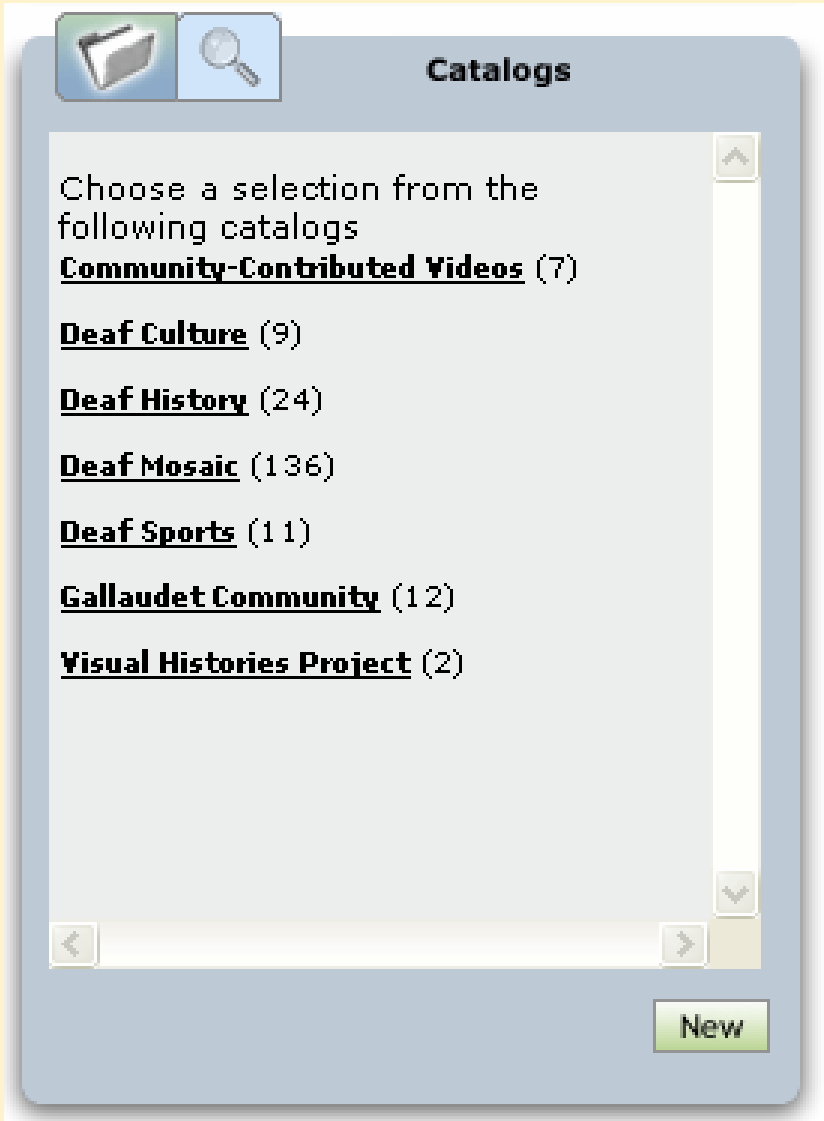
- Based on North Plains Systems Telescope Enterprise Digital Asset Management System (<http://www.northplains.com>)

  - Memories

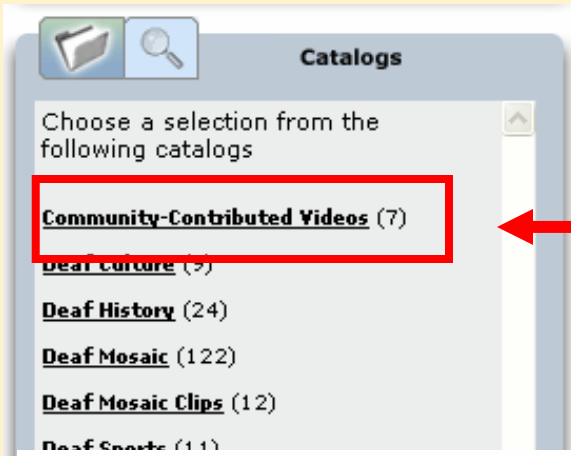

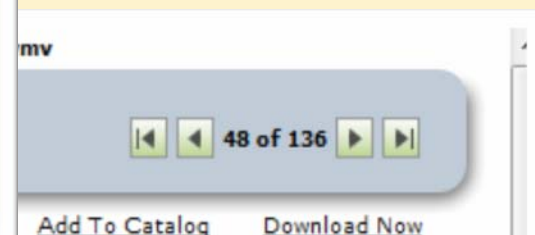


# Video Library: User Interface
